# HISTORY

#### THE BEST COMPETITION EVER!

The history of the FIFG FootGolf World Cup is still relatively short, but this edition is set to mark a turning point on the history of the sport. This spectacle of the world's best FootGolf will be broadcast live during the Finals.

Considered by some as the most beautiful of competitions, the world cup is the meeting of the best footgolfers on the planet. A where mix popular fervor, competitive spirit and sporting prowess. Initially played individually, the FIFG FootGolf World Cup is now also played as teams, encouraging players to represent their own country.

June 2012 - Hungary (Magyar Golf Club)

The Hungarian **Bela LENGYEL** is the 1st FootGolf World Champion. 8 nationalities competed during this first opus including Argentina, Belgium, Greece, Mexico, Hungary, Italy, the Netherlands and the United States.

January 2016 - Argentina (Pilar Golf Club)



The Argentinian **Christian OTERO** is crowned in individual competition. The USA wins the first country competition in the history of FootGolf. 230 players from 26 different countries were present at the Pilar Golf Club for the  $2^{nd}$  edition of the competition.

December 2018 - Morocco (Al Maaden & Montgomerie)

**33** countries will be represented, 500 players are registered, and for the first time, 3 categories will be rewarded. Beyond the Men category, this edition will reward the first Senior World Champion (+46 years) and the first Lady World Champion.



#### INFORMATION / RULES

#### Alcohol

Alcohol cannot be consumed on the course (Except in the Bar Zones). Players cannot consume alcohol when playing.

#### **Caddies**

Caddies are permitted under the following guidelines

#### A caddie:

- Can NOT be a player within any category in the individual event
- Must be clearly identified and wear a bib at all times on the course
- Must be identified before the start of play and cannot be changed during play
- Can ONLY caddie for one player per group\*
  \*It is permitted to caddy for one player in R1 AM and another R1 PM

Note: In the team event ANY player is eligible to caddie.

Note: In the team event only players and caddies competing are allowed on the playing zones.



#### **COMMUNICATION RULES**

#### President

Communicate with players YES Wear identification bib NO Player or non-player YES

#### Captain

Communicate with players YES
Wear identification bib When not playing
Player or non-player YES

#### Coach

Communicate with players YES
Wear identification bib YES
Player or non-player Must be non-player

#### Caddie

Communicate with players YES Wear identification bib YES Player or non-player YES\*

#### **Players**

\*See Caddie Rules

Players in the individual event will only be permitted to communicate with official designated team managers/ coaches, captain or President outside of their group (Each MUST be clearly identified on the course at all times)

Players in the team event can communicate with all registered players, caddies and officials from their country.

Players are not allowed to communicate with supporters at all times

Penalty for breach of this rule: offence 1 Warning, offence 2 +1 kick, offence 3 DQ



#### **Dress Code**

When competing players must wear official uniform including headwear and layered garments. At official functions the dress code will be decided by each FIFG representative. The dress code is smart casual (no sportswear)

As per FIFG Guidelines long socks must be worn to the knee at all times and Golf style shorts be worn.

Players are NOT permitted to wear individual sponsors on official kit.

Failure to adhere to dress code: Incident one warning, incident two Disqualification.

#### **Game Suspension**

Game suspension will be notified by three blasts of the siren. Please see FIFG Rule 1-3-11

#### **Golf Carts**

Players are not permitted to use golf carts including carrying their equipment.

Each country will have the option to rent one golf cart (Teams with 16+ players will have two carts) for officials ONLY.

In terms of the FIFG rules this cart will belong to the kicking player of the same association (4-1-13 and 4-1-14).

Golf carts must remain on the cart path where possible and can NOT enter any playing zone.

#### **Tournament Meeting**

A meeting will take place from 1830-1930 in the tournament office on each night from Sunday 9 December to Saturday 15 December. The team captain and/or FIFG representative is invited to attend.

#### **Tournament Office**

Each hotel will have a Tournament HQ with information, scores and tee times. Each venue will have a tournament office with the main office located at Al Maaden.

#### **Smoking**

Smoking electronic cigarettes on the course is strictly prohibited by competing players.

#### **Supporters**

Supporters are kindly requested to NOT enter the playing zones. They are NOT allowed onto tees, fairways or green zones including Golf greens. They are NOT permitted to communicate with players





#### The Draw & Cuts - Individual Event

#### R1 Draw

Announced during the opening ceremony.

Squads will be decided by 2018 World Tour ranking\* The total field will be split into four groups of an equal number based on their ranking position. Players without a World Tour ranking will be allocated to Group D.

The previous World Champions will be allocated to Group A. Each flight will be drawn randomly from the respective group.

Group A : Top 25% of players entered according to WT2018 ranking (Example: If 360 players entered then this will be the highest 90 players on the World Tour)

Group B : 26%-50% Group C : 51%-75%

Group D: 76% + Any players without a ranking

Ladies and Seniors will be drawn in 4 groups per category according to WT2018 ranking. Players without a WT ranking will be drawn on the latter holes. WT#1 will start from Hole 1.

Group A: Top 25% of players entered according to WT2018 ranking

Group B : 26%-50% Group C : 51%-75%

Group D: 76% + Any players without a ranking

\*Player ranking as of November 20th 2018

#### R2 Draw

Announced on Monday 10 December at 2100 Players will be drawn according to their R1 score within their groups. The lower scores will start from Hole 1 and so on

Ladies and Seniors will be drawn in score order (leaders starting on Hole 1).

#### Cut 1

The Top 220 and ties will continue and play Al Maadan 2 in R3

#### R3 Draw

Announced on Wednesday 12 December at 1900 Play will be in flight (tee times) from 0830 with leaders starting last.

Those players missing the cut will be competing for positions 221+ and will tee off in flight from Hole 1 on Al Maadan 1 (leaders last)

#### Cut 2

The Top 100 and ties will continue and play Al Maadan 1 in R4 Players 101-220 will play AM2

Ladies & Seniors CUT: the top 25 Ladies and Seniors will play the final round

#### R4 Draw

Announced on Saturday 15 December at 1900 Play will be in flight (tee times) from 0830/1100 with leaders starting last.

#### **Playoff Situations**

For the Championship: 3 holes playoff (Holes 5, 17 & 18 AM1) In the event of a tie penalty putts will decide the winner

For positions 2 & 3 : single hole playoff (Hole 18 AM1) In the event of a tie penalty putts will decide the winner.





#### The Draw & Cuts - Team Event

#### Qualification

Top 16 countries ranked by top 4 individual scores after R2 of the Men competition. In the event of a tie the lowest individual scores per country will determine the ranking.

#### **Player Selection**

Countries are eligible to choose 10 players plus 3 subs in the following criteria

- Singles x 4 (No substitutions permitted)
- Foursomes match 1 (One substitute)
- Foursomes match 2 (One substitute)
- Fourball match (One substitute)

In the event a team does not have a full quota of players they will forfeit those matches by the score of 1 point to nil with a goal difference of 18-0.

#### **Deadlines**

The official team line up must be submitted by the following deadlines

Last 16 Matches : the final list must be submitted to the Tournament Director no later than 2000 on Tuesday 11 Dec

Quarter Finals : the final list must be submitted to the Tournament Director no later than 1300 on Wednesday 12 December

Semi Finals: the final list must be submitted to the Tournament Director no later than 2000 on Friday 14 December.

Final : the final list must be submitted to the Tournament Director no later than 1300 on Saturday 15 December.

Once submitted no changes will be permitted.

In the event this list is not submitted on time the team will forfeit Hole 1 in all matches.

The Tournament Director will be at Al Maaden in The tournament office from 1830-1930 after each days play. The team sheet must be submitted folded into the box in the tournament office.

#### **Scoring Format**

18 Hole FootGolf Matchplay using win a hole, score a goal format

- Match won = 1 point
- Match tied = zero points

In the event of a tied complete match the total number of holes won (goal difference) will decide the tie therefore all 18 holes will need to be contested by all matches.

#### Team Event Rules

The Team event will be played within the guidelines set out by FIFG Rules 2018 and those tournament rules as detailed below

#### Caddies

Caddies are permitted and will be liable to sanctions in accordance with those rules that apply to players. Caddies must be paired with an individual player. Caddies will be permitted to mark the ball as a forecaddie.

The captain must identify which caddie belongs to which player. Players competing in the individual event can only be named as caddies in the team event

All caddies must wear caddy bibs at all times.

#### Disputes

In the event of a dispute then the match referee will make a decision in accordance with the rules. In the event that either team disputes this then the tournament director will make a final decision before the next hole is played. Note Only the FIFG representative or Team Captain can consult with match officials



#### **Formats**

Fourball Betterball – Played in pairs each player kicks their own ball and the lowest individual score per pair is recorded.

FootGolf Foursomes – A variation of Golf style foursomes, this is played in pairs using one ball where any player can kick off then the hole played with alternate shots until finished. Any player can then kick off the next tee.

Singles – head to head matches played as individuals

#### Order of Play

As per FIFG Rules, the order of play from the tee is determined by previous hole. Order of play from the fairway is determined by the furthest ball from the hole. Note: A team can alter their order should they wish. Any player is permitted to 'finish' when on the green zone.

#### Pace of Play

Play will be dictated by the pace of play guide and player timings. Teams have two minutes after the completion of the previous hole to name a replacement for the next hole.

The first player to play from any zone on the course has 60 seconds to complete their shot. The subsequent players have 40 seconds once the previous shot is dead.

A pace of play guide will be issued to all Team Captains

#### Poor Weather including bad light

In the event of poor weather a match may be suspended. If no further play is possible then matches will continue onto Friday 14 December. Suspension of play will be decided by the TD.

In the event that poor weather delays the semi final or final then the number of holes may be reduced to complete the match

#### Player communication

Players are permitted to communicate with all registered players, officials and registered caddies.

#### Qualifying

Nations will be seeded 1-16 based on their top four scores after R2 of the individual men's event.

The knockout stages will follow a pre-determined match tree

#### Registration

It is the role of the Team representative to name all 10 players in order with relevant substitutes and caddies. Caddies must wear bibs for identification. Deadlines for each round are noted within the schedule. Failure to adhere to this deadline will result in each match losing Hole 1.

#### Scoring and Ties

An official team scorecard will be issued to each Captain/Representative. It is the role of this person to correctly complete the card for the match.

The matches will be played using 'win a hole, score a goal' scoring whereby all 18 holes are required to be played to allow a 'goal difference' calculation to be used in the event of a tie.

In the event of a tie after goal difference then penalty putts will decide the tie. The location will be chosen by the match referee and will be a minimum of 10m. Each nation must choose five different players. If after 5 putts per team there is still a tie then a country can choose any player to kick next.

#### Starting

Each team must be present on the starting hole 10 minutes before the first kick of the match. Any player not present will forfeit Hole 1 (Example Match start 08:00 then all competing players and captain must be present with match referee at 07:50)





#### Substitutions

A maximum of three substitutes can be named by each team captain. These three will be allocated to one pairs match each and cannot change once submitted

A team has two minutes from the time the putt drops into the previous hole to notify the match referee of their intention. A substitute must then play the next hole. As soon as the team who has the honour has kicked off then no substitute can be made

Injury

In the event of an injury during a singles match, the match will be forfeited and the remaining holes awarded to the opposing team. If a player during a pairs match is injured then the substitute becomes the player. If there are no substitutes then the match will be forfeited and the remaining holes awarded to the opposing team.

#### Teams

A team will consist of a minimum 4 and maximum 13 players. Four players will play singles.

A minimum of one player and a maximum of three will play a fourball match. A minimum of two players and a maximum of three will play foursomes.

A team can consist of Men (any age) or women which is the choice of the captain.

Players travelling to Marrakech as solely part of the team are not eligible to compete in their respective individual category.

#### The Courses

The round of 16 and The Quarter Finals will be played on AL Maaden 2 The Semi Finals and Final will be played on Al Maaden 1 The Final will be played on Al Maaden 1 Each course will only have one set of tees.
